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Management Discussion of Fund Performance

This Management Discussion of Fund Performance presents the portfolio management team's view on the significant factors and developments that have affected the performance and outlook of Canada Life Canadian Growth Balanced Fund (the "Fund") in the six-month period ended September 30, 2024 (the "period"). If the Fund was established during the period, "period" represents the period since inception.

In this report, "CLIML" and "the Manager" refer to Canada Life Investment Management Ltd., which is a subsidiary of The Canada Life Assurance Company ("Canada Life"). The Manager has entered into a fund administration agreement with Mackenzie Financial Corporation ("Mackenzie"), an affiliate of the Manager and Canada Life, for administrative services. In addition, net asset value ("NAV") refers to the value of the Fund as calculated for transaction purposes, on which the discussion of Fund performance is based.

Results of Operations

Investment Performance

The performance of all series in the current and previous periods is shown in the *Past Performance* section of the report. Performance will vary by series primarily because fees and expenses differ between series, or because securities of a series were not issued and outstanding for the entire reporting period. Please refer to the *Fund Formation and Series Information* section of this report for the varying management and administration fees payable by each series. The following comparison to market indices is intended to help investors understand the Fund's performance relative to the general performance of the markets. However, the Fund's mandate may be different from that of the indices shown.

During the period, the Fund's A Series securities returned 4.6% (after deducting fees and expenses paid by the series). This compares with a return of 8.4% for a blended index composed of a 65% weighting in the Fund's broad-based index, the S&P/TSX Composite Index (returned 10.0%), and a 35% weighting in the FTSE Canada Universe Bond Index (returned 5.6%). All index and series returns are calculated on a total return basis in Canadian dollar terms. Investors cannot invest in an index without incurring fees, expenses and commissions, which are not reflected in the index returns.

Canadian equities rose over the period despite volatility, with the financials sector and mining stocks leading market performance. In response to weak economic data and falling inflation, the Bank of Canada reduced its policy rate three times, to 4.25% from 5.00%, and bond yields declined. Canada's unemployment rate rose to 6.4%, highlighting labour market weakness, while wage growth remained elevated. U.S. equities performed strongly over the period, driven by the information technology and communication services sectors. Moreover, the U.S. Federal Reserve cut its federal funds rate by 50 basis points, indicating its commitment to fostering economic growth. Defensive sectors, such as consumer staples and health care, lagged as fears of recession eased.

Within the S&P/TSX Composite Index, materials, utilities and financials were the best-performing sectors, while health care, industrials and energy were the weakest.

The Fund underperformed the broad-based index because of its allocation to fixed income, which underperformed equities in the period. Given the Fund's mandate, the return of the blended index is a more meaningful comparison.

The Fund underperformed the blended index, with the equity portfolio underperforming the equity portion of the blended index.

Within the equity portion of the Fund, stock selection in Canada detracted from performance, as did holdings in the United States. In sector terms, stock selection in materials and information technology detracted from performance, as did overweight exposure to industrials. Conversely, underweight exposure to the energy sector and stock selection in the consumer discretionary sector contributed to performance, as did holdings in France.

Within the fixed income portion of the Fund, the portfolio's cash position detracted from performance as markets rose. Conversely, a longer duration (higher sensitivity to interest rates) in federal bonds contributed to performance as interest rates fell. The portfolio's holdings in long government bond futures, used to manage duration, contributed to performance.

Over the period, neither portfolio activity nor market developments significantly changed the positioning of the Fund.

Net Assets

The Fund's net assets increased by 22.1% during the period to \$127.8 million. This change was composed primarily of \$6.6 million in net income (including any interest and/or dividend income) from investment performance, after deducting fees and expenses, and an increase of \$16.5 million due to net securityholder activity (including sales, redemptions and cash distributions).

Fees and Expenses

The annualized management expense ratio ("MER") for each series during the period ended September 30, 2024, was generally similar to the MER for the year ended March 31, 2024. Total expenses paid vary from period to period mainly as a result of changes in average assets in each series. The MERs for all series are presented in the *Financial Highlights* section of this report.

Recent Developments

Equity markets were buoyed over the period by expectations of more accommodative monetary policy, with interest rate cuts from the Bank of Canada, the European Central Bank and the U.S. Federal Reserve as evidence. Economic growth was uneven from the standpoint of global gross domestic product, with the United States showing mixed, but still relatively healthy, signals, while Canada, Europe and Asia were generally softer.

Despite exciting recent developments in artificial intelligence, the area is still marked by uncertainty. As a result, the equity portfolio management team focused on companies that it believes are global leaders in strong positions to benefit from this important long-term change by offering new applications and other enablers of growth to their clients. The team believes it is prudent to invest in this way to avoid the volatility often associated with emerging technologies.

The fixed income portfolio management team believes that economic weakness in the period justified the Bank of Canada's policy rate cuts, and that the pace of further economic deterioration will determine the frequency and magnitude of future reductions. Because the team expects accommodative monetary policy to continue in response to declining economic indicators, the team favours having duration exposure (sensitivity to changes in interest rates) in North America.

Effective July 17, 2024, IPC Investment Corporation and IPC Securities Corporation were added as principal distributors for the Fund, alongside Quadrus Investment Services Ltd.

Effective October 1, 2024, the manager, trustee, portfolio manager and promoter of the Fund, CLIML, amalgamated with Counsel Portfolio Services Inc., whereupon the amalgamated company, named CLIML, continued to serve as the manager, trustee, portfolio manager and promoter of the Fund. This is not a material change for the Fund.

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Effective November 7, 2024, the investment strategies of the Fund were changed to reflect a multi-portfolio manager approach, with each portfolio management team focusing on a different asset class and/or geographic region as follows:

- Canadian Equity The team employs a growth strategy, seeking to invest in companies expected to outpace market growth with a focus on selecting stocks with strong revenue growth, improving market performance, and appealing valuations relative to industry peers and historical norms.
- U.S. Equity The team employs a company-focused investment approach, targeting companies with strong management, promising growth potential, and solid financial positions while prioritizing investing at reasonable prices relative to the growth that companies in the portfolio are expected to achieve.
- Canadian Focused Small-Mid Cap Equity Two dedicated geographic portfolio management teams focus on managing a portion of the Fund as follows: The first team focuses on selecting Canadian small- and mid-cap stocks with strong earnings growth, sound fundamentals and appealing valuation compared to industry peers and historical norms. The second team focuses on U.S. mid-cap companies with sound management, solid growth potential and attractive financial metrics with a focus on investing at reasonable prices relative to the growth that companies in the portfolio are expected to achieve.

Related Party Transactions

Management and Administration Services

For each applicable series, the Fund paid management fees and administration fees to the Manager at the annual rates specified under *Fund Formation and Series Information* in this report and as more fully described in the Simplified Prospectus. In return for the administration fees, the Manager pays all costs and expenses (other than certain specified fund costs) required to operate the Fund that are not included in management fees. See also *Management Fees*.

Other Related Party Transactions

At September 30, 2024, the Fund had \$0.8 million (0.6% of the Fund's NAV) invested in underlying funds managed by Mackenzie. In making the investment(s), the Manager relied on a standing instruction from the Canada Life Funds' Independent Review Committee. The Manager's policies are designed to ensure that any related party transaction (i) is made free from any influence by an entity related to the Manager and without taking into account any considerations relevant to an entity related to the Manager; (ii) represents the business judgment of the Manager, uninfluenced by considerations other than the best interests of the Fund; and (iii) achieves a fair and reasonable result for the Fund.

Certain other investment funds managed by CLIML and segregated fund policies issued by Canada Life may invest in the Fund on a prospectus-exempt basis in accordance with the investment objectives of those funds. At September 30, 2024, these other investment funds and segregated funds owned 90.5% of the Fund's NAV. All related party transactions are based on the NAV per security on each transaction day. As a result of these investments, the Fund may be subject to large transaction risk as discussed in the Fund's Simplified Prospectus. CLIML manages this risk to reduce the possibility of any adverse effect on the Fund or on its investors, through such processes as requiring advance notice of large redemptions.

At September 30, 2024, Canada Life had an investment of \$0.04 million in the Fund (less than 0.1% of the Fund's NAV).

During the period, the Fund relied on standing instructions provided by the Canada Life Funds' Independent Review Committee for inter-fund trades that have occurred in the Fund.



Management Fees

The management fee for each applicable series is calculated and accrued daily as a percentage of its NAV. The Fund's management fees were used by the Manager in part to pay Mackenzie, an affiliate of the Manager, for investment advisory services, including managing the investment portfolio of the Fund and/or the underlying fund(s), as applicable, including providing investment analysis and recommendations, making investment decisions and making brokerage arrangements for the purchase and sale of the investment portfolio.

The Manager is responsible for paying certain administrative costs and all sales commissions, trailing commissions and any other compensation (collectively, "distribution-related payments") to registered dealers whose clients invest in the Fund. As principal distributors for the Fund, Quadrus Investment Services Ltd. ("Quadrus"), IPC Investment Corporation and IPC Securities Corporation (collectively, the "Principal Distributors," individually, a "Principal Distributor"), each an affiliate of the Manager, are paid trailing commissions out of the management fees.

The Manager used approximately 38% of the total management fee revenues received from all Canada Life Mutual Funds during the period to fund distribution-related payments to Principal Distributors and authorized dealers. In comparison, such distribution-related payments for the Fund represented on average 48% of the management fees paid by all applicable series of the Fund during the period. The actual percentage for each series may be higher or lower than the average depending on the level of trailing commissions and sales commissions paid for that series. The higher proportion of distribution-related payments is primarily attributable to sales commissions related to gross sales of redemption charge securities of the Fund.

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Fund Formation and Series Information

The Fund may have undergone a number of changes, such as a reorganization or a change in manager, mandate or name. A history of the major changes affecting the Fund in the last 10 years can be found in the Fund's Simplified Prospectus.

Date of Formation: August 14, 2020

The Fund may issue an unlimited number of securities of each series. The number of issued and outstanding securities of each series is disclosed under Financial Highlights.

A Series and T5 Series securities are offered to investors investing a minimum of \$500. Investors in T5 Series securities also want to receive a monthly cash flow of 5% per year.

F Series and F5 Series securities are offered to investors investing a minimum of \$500, who are enrolled in a fee-for-service or wrap program sponsored by a Principal Distributor and who are subject to an asset-based fee. Investors in F5 Series securities also want to receive a monthly cash flow of 5% per year.

N Series and N5 Series securities are offered to investors investing a minimum of \$500, who have eligible minimum total holdings of \$500,000, and who have entered into an N Series Account Agreement with CLIML and a Principal Distributor. Investors in N5 Series securities also want to receive a monthly cash flow of 5% per year.

QF Series and QF5 Series securities are offered to retail investors investing a minimum of \$500. Investors are required to negotiate their advisor service fee, which cannot exceed 1.25%, with their advisor. Investors in QF5 Series securities also want to receive a monthly cash flow of 5% per year.

QFW Series and QFW5 Series securities are offered to high net worth investors investing a minimum of \$500 who have eligible minimum total holdings of \$500,000. Investors are required to negotiate their advisor service fee, which cannot exceed 1.25%, with their advisor. Investors in QFW5 Series securities also want to receive a monthly cash flow of 5% per year.

Series R securities are offered only to other funds managed by CLIML on a non-prospectus basis in connection with fund-of-fund arrangements.

Series S securities are offered to The Canada Life Assurance Company and certain other mutual funds, but may be sold to other investors as determined by CLIML. W Series and W5 Series securities are offered to investors investing a minimum of \$500 who have eligible minimum total holdings of \$500,000. Investors in W5 Series securities also want to receive a monthly cash flow of 5% per year.

An investor in the Fund may choose among different purchase options that are available under each series. These purchase options are a sales charge purchase option, a redemption charge purchase option,[†] a low-load purchase option[†] and a no-load purchase option. The charges under the sales charge purchase option are negotiated by investors with their dealers. The charges under the redemption charge and low-load purchase options are paid to CLIML if an investor redeems securities of the Fund during specific periods. Not all purchase options are available under each series of the Fund, and the charges for each purchase option may vary among the different series. For further details on these purchase options, please refer to the Fund's Simplified Prospectus and Fund Facts.
